Amend C.S.H.B. 2 (house committee report) on page 60 by 1 striking lines 9 through 23 and substituting the following: 2 Sec. 29.0056. INFORMATION ON COMMUNITY-BASED SUPPORTS AND 3 RESIDENTIAL OPTIONS. (a) In this section, "state supported living 4 center" has the meaning assigned by Section 531.002, Health and 5 Safety Code. 6 (b) The Health and Human Services Commission, in 7 collaboration with the agency and stakeholders, shall develop and 8 provide to the agency materials regarding residential options and 9 supports for children who may qualify for home and community-based 10 supports or a residential placement. The agency shall make the 11 materials developed under this subsection available to school 12 13 districts. 14 (c) The materials must include information regarding: (1) the local intellectual and developmental 15 disability authority; and 16 (2) community-based supports and residential options, 17 18 including: 19 (A) the following waiver programs established under Section 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 20 21 1396n(c)): 22 (i) the youth empowerment services program; 23 (ii) the home and community-based services 24 program; 25 (iii) the Texas home living program; (iv) the community living assistance and 26 27 support services program; and 28 (v) the deaf-blind with multiple 29 disabilities program;

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- 2 with an intellectual or developmental disability who receive care
- 3 in intermediate care facilities other than a state supported living
- 4 center; and
- 5 (C) state supported living centers.

- 7 under Subsection (b) in the notice of procedural safeguards under
- 8 20 U.S.C. Section 1415(b).
