4 FOR the purpose of ~~requiring~~ authorizing each health care facility to screen each patient

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

**SUBTITLE 25. HEALTH CARE EQUITY FOR ~~WARRIOR~~ SERVICE MEMBER
COMMUNITY MEMBERS.**

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
INDICATED.

(B) (1) “HEALTH CARE FACILITY” MEANS A FACILITY OR AN OFFICE
WHERE HEALTH CARE IS PROVIDED TO PATIENTS BY A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER
OR GROUP OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS LICENSED, CERTIFIED, OR OTHERWISE
AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

(2) “HEALTH CARE FACILITY” INCLUDES:

(I) A HOSPITAL, AS DEFINED IN § 19–301 OF THIS ARTICLE;

(II) A FREESTANDING MEDICAL FACILITY, AS DEFINED IN §
19–3A–01 OF THIS ARTICLE;

(III) A NURSING FACILITY;

(IV) A RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER;

(V) A REHABILITATION FACILITY; AND

(VI) A FACILITY OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION, OR A HEALTH OFFICER.

~~(1) THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES;~~

~~(3) THE NATIONAL GUARD OF ANY STATE~~ HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-901 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

~~(D) “VETERAN” MEANS A FORMER SERVICE MEMBER WHO WAS DISCHARGED FROM ACTIVE DUTY.~~

~~(E)~~ (D) “WARRIOR SERVICE MEMBER COMMUNITY MEMBER” MEANS:

(1) A SERVICE MEMBER;

(2) A VETERAN;

(3) THE SPOUSE OF A SERVICE MEMBER OR VETERAN;

(4) A CHILD OF A SERVICE MEMBER OR VETERAN; OR

(5) A STEPCHILD OF A SERVICE MEMBER OR VETERAN.

~~(E) “VETERAN” MEANS A FORMER SERVICE MEMBER WHO WAS DISCHARGED FROM ACTIVE DUTY~~ HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-901 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(A) EACH HEALTH CARE FACILITY ~~SHALL~~ MAY SCREEN EACH PATIENT FOR INFORMATION ON THE PATIENT’S ELIGIBILITY AS A ~~WARRIOR SERVICE MEMBER~~ WARRIOR SERVICE MEMBER COMMUNITY MEMBER AND INCLUDE IN THE PATIENT’S MEDICAL RECORD WHETHER THE PATIENT IS A ~~WARRIOR SERVICE MEMBER~~ WARRIOR SERVICE MEMBER COMMUNITY MEMBER.

(B) FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING HEALTH CARE EQUITY FOR ~~WARRIOR~~ SERVICE MEMBER COMMUNITY MEMBERS, EACH HEALTH CARE FACILITY ~~SHALL~~ MAY IDENTIFY ~~WARRIOR~~ SERVICE MEMBER COMMUNITY MEMBERS AS A VULNERABLE POPULATION AND COMPLY WITH THE STANDARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NATIONAL PATIENT SAFETY GOAL TO IMPROVE HEALTH CARE EQUITY ESTABLISHED BY THE JOINT COMMISSION.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) “Board” means the Board of Trustees of the Maryland Veterans Trust.

(c) “Department” means the Department of Veterans and Military Families.

(D) “RESERVE COMPONENT” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 37 U.S.C. § 101.

~~[(d)]~~ **(E) “Secretary” means the Secretary of Veterans and Military Families.**

(F) “SERVICE MEMBER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A MEMBER OF:

(1) THE UNIFORMED SERVICES; OR

(2) A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES.

~~[(e)]~~ **(G) “Trust” means the Maryland Veterans Trust.**

(H) “UNIFORMED SERVICES” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 37 U.S.C. § 101.

~~[(f)]~~ **(I) Except as otherwise provided [in this subtitle], “veteran” [means an individual who served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, other than for training, and was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable] HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 38 U.S.C. § 101.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
