## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS TO BE  
10 IDENTIFIED AS A TREATING PROVIDER FOR INSURANCE  
11 BILLING AND CLAIMS AND TO BILL AND RECEIVE PAYMENT  
12 FOR PROVIDED HEALTHCARE SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

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17 TO AUTHORIZE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS TO BE  
18 IDENTIFIED AS A TREATING PROVIDER FOR  
19 INSURANCE BILLING AND CLAIMS AND TO BILL  
20 AND RECEIVE PAYMENT FOR PROVIDED  
21 HEALTHCARE SERVICES.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-105-101, concerning definitions  
27 regarding licensure and regulation of physician assistants, is amended to add  
28 additional subdivisions to read as follows:

29 (4) "Health benefit plan" means a plan, policy, contract,  
30 certificate, agreement, or other evidence of coverage for healthcare services  
31 offered or issued by a healthcare insurer in this state; and

32 (5)(A) "Healthcare insurer" means an entity that is subject to  
33 state insurance regulation and provides health insurance in this state.

34 (B) "Healthcare insurer" includes:

35 (i) An insurance company;

36 (ii) A hospital and medical service corporation;



- 1                   (iii) A health maintenance organization;
- 2                   (iv) A risk-based provider organization; and
- 3                   (v) Any sponsor of a nonfederal self-funded
- 4 governmental plan.

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6           SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 105, Subchapter 1, is

7 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

8           17-105-125. Insurer billing and payment.

9           A physician assistant shall be:

10                   (1) Identified as the treating provider in billing and claims

11 processes when the physician assistant delivered the medical services to the

12 patient; and

13                   (2) Authorized to bill for and receive direct payment for

14 medically necessary services delivered by the physician assistant to a

15 patient that:

16                                   (A) Is a Medicaid beneficiary; or

17                                   (B) Has a health benefit plan provided by a healthcare

18 insurer.
