No. 3070 (barcode 1 891238) as follows: 2 (1) On page 2, between lines 30 and 31, add the following 3 ^ 4 appropriately numbered subdivision to proposed Section 466.005(b), 5 Government Code, and renumber subsequent subdivisions and crossreferences to those subdivisions accordingly: 6 7 () assessing whether the department has sufficient tools, programs, and procedures to ensure the integrity of the 8 9 state lottery program; 10 (2) On page 18, line 16, strike "the executive director or" 11 and substitute "[the executive director or]". (3) On page 18, line 18, strike "an employee or" and 12 13 substitute "a [an employee or]". (4) On page 18, strike lines 19 through 21, and substitute 14 15 the following: 16 department who the executive director determines: (A) has or will have access to sensitive or 17 18 confidential data relating to this chapter or Chapter 2001, 19 Occupations Code; or (B) has or will have as the employee's or 20 prospective employee's primary role the administration of this 21

- 25 (7) On page 56, line 30, immediately following the period,

- 1 insert "A license placed on administrative hold before the
- 2 effective date of this Act may continue on hold for a period not
- 3 to exceed 10 years from the effective date of this Act as
- 4 determined by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation."
- 5 (8) On page 57, line 16, strike "Not later than March 1,
- 6 2026" and substitute "As soon as practicable after the effective
- 7 date of this Act".
- 8 (9) On page 58, line 1, strike "January 1, 2027" and
- 9 substitute "December 1, 2026".
- 10 (10) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 11 the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 12 SECTION . Section 2001.407, Occupations Code, is amended
- 13 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (c-1), (c-2),
- 14 (c-3), and (c-4) to read as follows:
- 15 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), a [A] licensed
- 16 distributor may not receive by purchase or otherwise bingo
- 17 equipment or supplies from a person other than a licensed
- 18 manufacturer or another licensed distributor.
- 19 (c-1) A licensed distributor may receive bingo equipment or
- 20 supplies from a licensed authorized organization if:
- 21 (1) the distributor delivered the equipment or supplies
- 22 to the organization; and
- 23 (2) the equipment or supplies were:
- 24 (A) defective;
- 25 (B) not ordered by the organization; or
- 26 (C) delivered in a quantity that exceeds the
- 27 quantity the organization ordered.

- 1 (c-2) A licensed authorized organization that returns bingo
- 2 equipment or supplies to the licensed distributor as provided by
- 3 Subsection (c-1) shall:
- 4 (1) maintain a record specifying for each returned
- 5 equipment or supply:
- 6 (A) a reason for the return from the reasons
- 7 listed in Subsection (c-1)(2); and
- 8 (B) the quantity returned; and
- 9 (2) provide a copy of the record to the distributor.
- 10 (c-3) A licensed distributor that receives returned
- 11 equipment or supplies from a licensed authorized organization as
- 12 provided by Subsection (c-1) shall:
- 13 (1) maintain a record showing receipt of the returned
- 14 equipment or supplies; and
- 15 (2) provide a copy of the record to the organization.
- 16 (c-4) A licensed authorized organization may transfer a
- 17 card-minding device from the premises of the organization to the
- 18 premises of another licensed authorized organization if each
- 19 licensed authorized organization agrees to the transfer.
- 20 SECTION . Sections 2001.451(h) and (j), Occupations
- 21 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (h) Except as provided by Subsection (j), a licensed
- 23 authorized organization or a unit of licensed authorized
- 24 organizations may retain operating capital in the organization's
- 25 or unit's bingo account in an amount that:
- 26 (1) is equal to the organization's or unit's actual
- 27 average bingo expenses per quarter based on the preceding license

- 1 period, excluding prizes paid; and
- 2 (2) does not exceed a total of \$100,000 [\$50,000] for
- 3 a single organization or $\frac{$100,000}{}$ [\$50,000] for each member of a
- 4 unit unless:
- 5 (A) the commission by rule establishes a higher
- 6 amount for all organizations or units or one or more classes of
- 7 organizations or units; or
- 8 (B) the bingo operations director, on request,
- 9 raises the operating capital limit for one organization or unit as
- 10 necessary to facilitate the operation of the organization or unit.
- 11 (j) The commission shall adopt rules allowing a licensed
- 12 authorized organization to retain a maximum amount of operating
- 13 capital in the bingo account in excess of the amount provided by
- 14 Subsection (h) if the organization:
- 15 (1) has conducted bingo for less than one year;
- 16 (2) has been closed for at least six months;
- 17 (3) experiences circumstances beyond the control of the
- 18 organization, including force majeure, that necessitate an
- 19 increase in operating capital; or
- (4) [(3)] provides to the commission a credible
- 21 business plan for the conduct of bingo or for the organization's
- 22 existing or planned charitable purposes that an increase in
- 23 operating capital will reasonably further.
