- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee report) in Article I of
- 2 the bill, following the appropriations to the Office of the
- 3 Attorney General (page I-14), by adding the following appropriately
- 4 numbered rider:

- 5 ___. Contingent Fee Contract Payments. (a) Notwithstanding
- 6 any other provisions of this Act, in addition to the amounts
 - appropriated above for Strategy A.1.1, Legal Services, the Office
- 8 of the Attorney General is appropriated from recovered funds
- 9 deposited in the state treasury pursuant to an arrangement
- 10 described by Section 2254.108(c)(1), Government Code, for the state
- 11 fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2027, the amount necessary to pay
- 12 contingent fee contract payments, including contingent fees and
- 13 expense reimbursements, arising from a contingent fee contract
- 14 entered into by the office in the name of the state under Subchapter
- 15 C, Chapter 2254, Government Code, and in connection with which the
- 16 funds were recovered (estimated to be \$0 for the 2026-2027
- 17 biennium).
- 18 (b) A payment of contingent fees or the reimbursement of
- 19 expenses from money appropriated under this rider:
- 20 (1) may only be made on the successful deposit of the
- 21 recovered funds to the credit of the appropriate fund or account in
- 22 the state treasury, pursuant to an arrangement described by Section
- 23 2254.108(c)(1);
- 24 (2) must be made from the appropriate fund or account
- 25 in the state treasury in which the recovered funds were deposited;
- 26 and
- 27 (3) must be made in accordance with Subchapter C,
- 28 Chapter 2254, Government Code, including Section 2254.108,
- 29 Government Code.

- 1 (c) The Comptroller of Public Accounts shall prescribe
- 2 procedures to direct payments under this rider.
