23	the Department of Health and Human Services shall solicit feedback from mothers who are			
24	currently serving, or who formerly served, in the military. In addition, the DHHS shall consult with the Department of Military and Veterana Affairs (DMVA) as necessary. The DMVA shall

32	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of			
33	Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in nonrecurring			
34	funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year for the purpose of conducting the study described in Section			
35	1 of this act.			
36		SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
