- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (House committee printing) in Article
- 2 VII of the bill, following the appropriations to the Department of
- 3 Transportation (page VII-34), by adding the following
- 4 appropriately numbered rider:
- 5 \_\_\_\_. Study on Use of Unmanned Aerial Systems for
- 6 Cross-border Transport at Ports of Entry. (a) Out of funds
- 7 appropriated above to the Department of Transportation for Strategy
- 8 A.1.1, Plan/Design/Manage, the department shall conduct a study on
- 9 the feasibility of using unmanned aerial systems, including drones,
- 10 for the cross-border transport of lightweight commercial goods at
- 11 ports of entry on the border between this state and the United
- 12 Mexican States. The study must assess:
- 13 (1) relevant federal, state, and international
- 14 regulatory frameworks;
- 15 (2) infrastructure needs;
- 16 (3) airspace restrictions;
- 17 (4) safety and security protocols; and
- 18 (5) current use cases, including models used on the
- 19 border between the United States and Canada.
- 20 (b) In conducting the study, the Department of
- 21 Transportation shall consult with relevant state and federal
- 22 agencies, including:
- 23 (1) the Department of Public Safety;
- 24 (2) the United States Customs and Border Protection;
- 25 and
- 26 (3) the Federal Aviation Administration.
- 27 (c) Not later than December 1, 2026, the Department of
- 28 Transportation shall prepare and submit to the legislature a report
- 29 on the results of the study.
