

SENATE BILL 2782

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29;
Title 36; Title 37; Title 39 and Title 68, relative to
prohibited medical procedures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-33-103(a)(2)(B), is amended by deleting "located" and substituting instead "who resides".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-33-103, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

(d) A person shall not knowingly remove a minor from this state without the consent of a parent of the minor if the purpose of the removal is to assist the minor in obtaining a medical procedure that, if performed by a healthcare provider within this state, would be a violation of this section.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-33-105(a), is amended by deleting "68-33-104" and substituting instead "68-33-103(d) or 68-33-104".

SECTION 4. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
