## **General Assembly Of North Carolina**

Upon the execution of the affidavit, the declaring father shall be listed as the father on the 1 2 birth certificate, subject to the declaring father's right to rescind under G.S. 110-132. The 3 executed affidavit shall be filed with the registrar along with the birth certificate. In the event 4 paternity is properly placed at issue, a certified copy of the affidavit shall be admissible in any 5 action to establish paternity. The surname of the child shall be determined by the mother, except if the father's name is entered on the certificate, the mother and father shall agree upon the child's 6 7 surname. If there is no agreement, the child's surname shall be the same as that of the mother. 8 The execution and filing of this affidavit with the registrar does not affect rights of inheritance 9 unless the affidavit is also filed with the clerk of court in accordance with G.S. 29-19(b)(2)." 10 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the estates of

11 decedents opened on or after that date.
