Substitute the foliowing for the Bernal amendment to the amendment;

- 1 Amend Amendment No. by Bernal to C.S.H.B. 2 by striking the Collowing text to the amendment.
- 3 (1) On page 9, line 26, strike "Section 28.0211(a-1),
- 4 Education Code, is" and substitute "Sections 28.0211(a-1) and (a-
- 5 4), Education Code, are".
- 6 (2) On page 10, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:
- 7 (a-4) If a district receives funding under Section 29.0881
- 8 [or 48.104], the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental
- 9 Appropriations Act, 2021 (Div. M, Pub. L. No. 116-260), or the
- 10 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Pub. L. No. 117-2), then
- 11 supplemental instruction provided by a school district under
- 12 Subsection (a-1)(2) must:
- 13 (1) include targeted instruction in the essential
- 14 knowledge and skills for the applicable grade levels and subject
- 15 area;
- 16 (2) be provided in addition to instruction normally
- 17 provided to students in the grade level in which the student is
- 18 enrolled;
- 19 (3) be provided during the subsequent summer or school
- 20 year:
- 21 (A) to each student for no less than:
- 22 (i) 15 hours; or
- 23 (ii) 30 hours for a student whose performance
- 24 on the applicable assessment instrument was significantly below
- 25 satisfactory, as defined by commissioner rule; and

- 1 (B) unless the instruction is provided to a
- 2 student fully during summer, no less than once per week during the
- 3 school year, except as otherwise provided by commissioner rule to
- 4 account for school holidays or shortened school weeks;
- 5 (4) be designed to assist the student in achieving
- 6 satisfactory performance in the applicable grade level and subject
- 7 area;
- 8 (5) include effective instructional materials designed
- 9 for supplemental instruction;
- 10 (6) be provided to a student individually or in a group
- 11 of no more than four students, unless the parent or guardian of
- 12 each student in the group authorizes a larger group;
- 13 (7) be provided by a person with training in the
- 14 applicable instructional materials for the supplemental
- 15 instruction and under the oversight of the school district; and
- 16 (8) to the extent possible, be provided by one person
- 17 for the entirety of the student's supplemental instruction period.
- 18 (3) On page 20, strike "\$6,500" and substitute "\$7,604" in
- 19 each of the following places it appears:
- 20 (A) line 23; and
- 21 (B) line 25.
- 22 (4) Strike page 24, line 10 through page 25, line 3.
- 23 (5) On page 25, line 19, strike "Section 48.108(a), Education
- 24 Code, is" and substitute "Sections 48.108(a) and (d), Education
- 25 Code, are".
- 26 (6) On page 26, between lines 1 and 2, insert the following:
- 27 (d) A school district may receive funding for a student under
- 28 this section and under <u>Sections 48.104 and</u>] 48.105[, as
- 29 applicable, of the student satisfies the requirements of each
- 30 applicable section.
- 31 (7) On page 26, lines 24 through 26, strike "of the point
- 32 value assigned to each student at a district campus under

- 1 Subsection (e) and substitute daily attendance [of the point
- 2 value assigned to each student] at a district campus [under
- 3 Subsection (e)]".
- 4 (8) On page 39, line 16, between "12.106(a-4)," and "and",
- 5 insert "12.263(d), 29.044(b), 29.089(b), 29.918, 48.104, 48.1041,
- 6 48.109(e), 48.112(e), (f), and (j),".
- 7 (9) On page 48, strike lines 22 through 25 and substitute the
- 8 following:
- 9 (b) The high needs and rural factor is 4.0.
- 10 (10) On page 49, strike lines 1 through 6 and substitute "this
- 11 <u>section.</u>".
- 12 (11) On page 50, line 21, strike "48.104," and substitute
- 13 "[48.104,]".
- 14 (12) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 15 Article 1 of the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill
- 16 accordingly:
- 17 SECTION 1. . Section 29.081(b-2), Education Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (b-2) A district that is required to provide accelerated
- 20 instruction under Subsection (b-1) shall separately budget
- 21 sufficient funds[, including funds under Section 48.104,] for that
- 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 1.\_\_. Section 29.082(a), Education Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 25 (a) A school district [may set aside an amount from the
- 26 district's allotment under Section 48.104 or] may apply to the
- 27 agency for funding of an extended year program for a period not to
- 28 exceed 30 instructional days for students in:
- 29 (1) kindergarten through grade 11 who are identified as
- 30 likely not to be promoted to the next grade level for the
- 31 succeeding school year; or

- 1 (2) grade 12 who are identified as likely not to
- 2 graduate from high school before the beginning of the succeeding
- 3 school year.
