1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 62A.30, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 5. **Mammogram; diagnostic services and testing.** (a) If a health care provider

1.9determines an enrollee requires additional diagnostic services or testing after a mammogram,

1.10a health plan must provide coverage for the additional diagnostic services or testing with

1.11no cost sharing, including co-pay, deductible, or coinsurance.

1.12(b) This section does not apply to Medical Assistance under chapter 256B and

1.13MinnesotaCare under chapter 256L.

1.14**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2022, and applies to health

1.15plans offered, issued, or sold on or after that date.
