- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1106 (house committee report) as follows:
- 2 (1) On page 1, line 5, strike "adding Subdivision (1-a) and
- 3 amending Subdivision (4)" and substitute "amending Subdivisions
- 4 (1) and (4) and adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (1-b)".
- 5 (2) On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:
- 6 (1) "Abuse" includes the following acts or omissions
- 7 by a person:
- 8 (A) mental or emotional injury to a child that
- 9 results in an observable and material impairment in the child's
- 10 growth, development, or psychological functioning;
- 11 (B) causing or permitting the child to be in a
- 12 situation in which the child sustains a mental or emotional injury
- 13 that results in an observable and material impairment in the
- 14 child's growth, development, or psychological functioning;
- 15 (C) physical injury that results in substantial
- 16 harm to the child, or the genuine threat of substantial harm from
- 17 physical injury to the child, including an injury that is at
- 18 variance with the history or explanation given and excluding an
- 19 accident or reasonable discipline by a parent, guardian, or
- 20 managing or possessory conservator that does not expose the child
- 21 to a substantial risk of harm;
- (D) failure to make a reasonable effort to
- 23 prevent an action by another person that results in physical injury
- 24 that results in substantial harm to the child;
- 25 (E) sexual conduct harmful to a child's mental,
- 26 emotional, or physical welfare, including conduct that constitutes
- 27 the offense of continuous sexual abuse of young child or disabled
- 28 individual under Section 21.02, Penal Code, indecency with a child
- 29 under Section 21.11, Penal Code, sexual assault under Section

- 1 22.011, Penal Code, or aggravated sexual assault under Section
- 2 22.021, Penal Code;
- 3 (F) failure to make a reasonable effort to
- 4 prevent sexual conduct harmful to a child;
- 5 (G) compelling or encouraging the child to engage
- 6 in sexual conduct as defined by Section 43.01, Penal Code,
- 7 including compelling or encouraging the child in a manner that
- 8 constitutes an offense of trafficking of persons under Section
- 9 20A.02(a)(7) or (8), Penal Code, solicitation of prostitution under
- 10 Section 43.021, Penal Code, or compelling prostitution under
- 11 Section 43.05(a)(2), Penal Code;
- 12 (H) causing, permitting, encouraging, engaging
- 13 in, or allowing the photographing, filming, or depicting of the
- 14 child if the person knew or should have known that the resulting
- 15 photograph, film, or depiction of the child is obscene as defined by
- 16 Section 43.21, Penal Code, or pornographic;
- 17 (I) the current use by a person of a controlled
- 18 substance as defined by Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, in a
- 19 manner or to the extent that the use results in physical, mental, or
- 20 emotional injury to a child;
- 21 (J) causing, expressly permitting, or
- 22 encouraging a child to use a controlled substance as defined by
- 23 Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code;
- 24 (K) causing, permitting, encouraging, engaging
- 25 in, or allowing a sexual performance by a child as defined by
- 26 Section 43.25, Penal Code;
- 27 (L) knowingly causing, permitting, encouraging,
- 28 engaging in, or allowing a child to be trafficked in a manner
- 29 punishable as an offense under Section 20A.02(a)(5), (6), (7), or
- 30 (8), Penal Code, or the failure to make a reasonable effort to
- 31 prevent a child from being trafficked in a manner punishable as an

- 1 offense under any of those sections; [or]
- 2 (M) forcing or coercing a child to enter into a
- 3 marriage; or
- 4 (N) forcing, coercing, or causing a child to
- 5 participate in conversion therapy.
- 6 (3) On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the
- 7 following:
- 8 (1-b) "Conversion therapy" means a practice or
- 9 treatment provided to a person by a health care provider or
- 10 <u>nonprofit organization</u> that seeks to:
- (A) change the person's sexual orientation,
- 12 including by attempting to change the person's behavior or gender
- 13 identity or expression; or
- (B) eliminate or reduce the person's sexual or
- 15 romantic attractions or feelings toward individuals of the same
- 16 <u>sex.</u>
