An act to amend Section 21193 of the Public Resources Code, relating to environmental protection.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 335, as introduced, Jones. California Environmental Protection Program: administration.

Existing law establishes the California Environmental Protection Program, which is concerned with the preservation and protection of California's environment. Existing law requires the program to be administered by the Secretary of the Natural Resources Agency.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to the above provision relating to the administration of the program.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

3 21193. (a) The program established by this division shall be 4 administered by the Secretary of the *Natural* Resources Agency.

6 forward those projects and programs recommended for funding to

7 the Governor for inclusion in the Governor's Budget, together with

8 a statement of the purpose of each project and program, the benefits

9 to be realized, and the secretary's comments thereon.

1 (c) The section of the Governor's Budget for the California

3 expenditures that includes a statement of the purpose and benefits4 to be realized for each project or program proposed for funding.

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
