- 7 (2) Inspections shall occur on or before the initial lease date and [each 8 year] AT LEAST BIENNIALLY thereafter IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PUBLIC HOUSING 9 AGENCY'S ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN.
