An act to amend Section 4452 of the Labor Code, relating to workers' compensation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1293, as introduced, Wallis. Workers' compensation.

Existing law establishes a workers' compensation system, administered by the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation, to compensate an employee for injuries sustained in the course of employment. Existing law sets forth methods for computing average annual earnings and minimums and maximum values in disability cases.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to a those provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4452 of the Labor Code is amended to 2 read:

3 4452. Four times the average annual earnings shall be taken

4 at not less than four thousand eight hundred dollars and sixty-four

5 cents (\$4,800.64) nor more than fifteen thousand two hundred

6 dollars and sixty-four cents (\$15,200.64) in disability cases, and

7 in death cases shall be taken at not less than the minimum nor more
