## AN ACT CONCERNING REVIEW OF ANIMAL CRUELTY LAWS BY THE CONNECTICUT SENTENCING COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Connecticut Sentencing
- 2 Commission established pursuant to section 54-300 of the general
- 3 statutes shall review animal cruelty laws, including those (1) under
- 4 chapter 945 of the general statutes, (2) under other provisions of the
- 5 general statutes, and (3) of other states. As part of such review, the
- 6 commission shall examine penalties for animal cruelty imposed by laws
- 7 of this state and other states and whether there are national or regional
- 8 trends concerning changes to such penalties.
- 9 (b) Not later than January 1, 2023, said commission shall report, in
- 10 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 11 on the review conducted under subsection (a) of this section and include
- 12 recommendations for legislation, if any, to the joint standing committee
- 13 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
- 14 judiciary and to the Governor.
