An Act requiring the supervision of animals at day care services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 137A of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:-

3           (e) Any commercial boarding or training kennel actively used for day care services shall  
4 ensure continuous supervision of all animals on such premises and shall be subject to inspection  
5 and license revocation as provided under Section 137C.
