- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article
- 2 III of the bill, following the appropriations to the Texas
- 3 Education Agency (page III-3), by adding the following
- 4 appropriately numbered rider and renumbering subsequent riders
- 5 accordingly:
- 6 ____. College, Career, and Military Readiness Outcome
- 7 Preparation Program. (a) Included in amounts appropriated above
- 8 to the Texas Education Agency in Strategy A.2.1, Statewide
- 9 Educational Programs, is \$1,000,000 from the general revenue fund
- 10 for each state fiscal year of the state fiscal biennium ending
- 11 August 31, 2027, for the Texas Education Agency to implement a
- 12 College, Career, and Military Readiness Outcome Preparation
- 13 Program to provide grants to school districts and open-enrollment
- 14 charter schools to:
- 15 (1) access advanced coursework for educationally
- 16 disadvantaged students, as defined by Section 5.001, Education
- 17 Code; and
- 18 (2) evaluate student college, career, and military
- 19 readiness.
- 20 (b) It is the intent of the Legislature that:
- 21 (1) the College, Career, and Military Readiness
- 22 Outcome Preparation Program increase the number of students meeting
- 23 college, career, and military readiness milestones and enhance the
- 24 ability of school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to
- 25 earn outcomes bonuses under Section 48.110, Education Code; and
- 26 (2) school districts and open-enrollment charter
- 27 schools that receive grants under the program partner with
- 28 nonprofit organizations with a record of improving access to
- 29 advanced coursework for educationally disadvantaged students, as

- 1 defined by Section 5.001, Education Code.
- 2 (c) The Texas Education Agency shall establish a list of
- 3 approved nonprofit organizations from which grant recipients may
- 4 choose to partner with under Subsection (b)(2) of this section.
- 5 (d) Not later than August 31 of each year of the state fiscal
- 6 biennium beginning September 1, 2025, the commissioner of education
- 7 shall:
- 8 (1) use currently available student performance data
- 9 and reporting from school districts and open-enrollment charter
- 10 schools that received grants during that state fiscal year to
- 11 prepare a report describing:
- 12 (A) program effectiveness;
- 13 (B) implementation activities by districts and
- 14 schools that received grants; and
- 15 (C) student and district outcomes meeting or
- 16 exceeding college, career, and military readiness benchmarks; and
- 17 (2) submit to the Governor and the Legislative Budget
- 18 Board and post on the agency's Internet website the report prepared
- 19 under Subdivision (1).
- 20 (e) Any unexpended balance of money allocated as described
- 21 by Subsection (a) of this rider remaining as of August 31, 2026, is
- 22 appropriated for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2027, for
- 23 the same purpose.
