7	"(q3) Autism Spectrum Disorder Designation. – The Division shall develop, in consultation						
8		ent of Public Safety, the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities,					
9	and Substance U	se Services, and the State Highway Patrol, and pursuant to this subsection, a					
10	drivers license de	esignation that may, upon request, be granted to a person with autism spectrum					
11	disorder, as defined in G.S. 58-3-192. The Division shall comply with the following requirements						
12	applicable to the						
13	<u>(1)</u>	At the request of a person with autism spectrum disorder, the Division shall					
14		enter the designation into the electronic record associated with the person's					
15		drivers license.					
16	<u>(2)</u>	For the purposes of this subsection, a person shall be considered to have					
17		autism spectrum disorder if the person provides verification or documentation					
18		substantiating a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder that is recommended					
19		by the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance					
20		Use Services as acceptable. The Division of Motor Vehicles shall consult with					
21		the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance					
22		Use Services to identify acceptable forms of verification that do not result in					
23		undue burden to the person requesting the designation of autism spectrum					
24		disorder. Acceptable documentation shall include any of the following:					
25		<u>a.</u> <u>Documentation of certification or examination by a medical, health, or</u>					
26		mental health professional showing evidence of autism spectrum					
27		disorder.					
28		b. Documentation deemed by the Division of Motor Vehicles to qualify					
29		as satisfactory proof of the person's autism spectrum disorder.					
30	<u>(3)</u>	Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as authorizing the issuance of a					
31		drivers license to a person ineligible under G.S. 20-9.					
32	<u>(4)</u>	Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as prohibiting the issuance of a					
33		drivers license to a person otherwise eligible under the law.					
34	<u>(5)</u>	Any individual who chooses to register or not to register shall not be deemed					
35		to have waived any protections under the law.
