FS-28C, FS-324B-POE, FS-348B, and FS-448B

## Summary of Enhancements

- FortiSwitch-448B models can be remotely managed by FortiGate units that support remote switch management.
- FortiSwitch-348B and 448B models support two links between the FortiGate unit and the FortiSwitch unit when the FortiSwitch unit is remotely managed by a FortiGate unit.

## **TFTP boot process**

The TFTP boot process erases all current switch configuration and replaces it with the factory default settings.

# Upgrade Information

## Upgrading from FortiSwitch v2.0.2 or later

FortiSwitch v2.0 Patch Release 3 build 0018 officially supports upgrade from FortiSwitch v2.0.2 or later.



If your FortiSwitch is configured in FortiLink mode (to be managed by a FortiGate unit), you should upgrade your FortiSwitch unit first, and then upgrade your FortiGate unit to FortiOS v5.0 Patch Release 5. See the [FortiOS v5.0 Patch Release 5 Release Notes](#) for information on upgrading your FortiGate device.

## Downgrading to previous firmware versions

Downgrading from FortiSwitch v2.0 Patch Release 3 build 0018 to previous firmware versions is not supported.
