Scholarship Rules and Guidelines

- Candidates may be required to secure their award by final presentation to the Tulsa Section Board.
- Applicants may apply during both application periods, however a new application must be submitted for each award period.
- Funds will be awarded to the candidate's approved educational facility to be used for any Program costs that are <u>directly billable through the academic institution</u>.
 - This includes but is not limited to: tuition, textbooks, safety equipment, and tools.
- Funds must be used within (1) year of award. Any unused funds will be forfeited to the AWS Tulsa Section after expiration.
- The student shall have "good academic standing" during the period when funds are used.
- The Tulsa Section Board may award any lesser scholarship amount at their discretion.
- <u>TULSA Section 34 Members</u> may use funds to attend any eligible welding or metallurgy school curriculum in the USA.
- Other AWS Section Members and AWS Non-members may be considered if funds are used to attend an eligible welding or metallurgy school curriculum in Oklahoma.

Essay Criteria

- Briefly Introduce yourself.
- Detail any current or previous involvement in the welding/fabrication community, current achievements, and future goals.
- State any other noteworthy achievements for the Board to consider and help make their determination.
