The annual meeting is a time to cast vision for the coming year and report on ministry outcomes from the previous year such as salvations, baptisms, growth in the church, community impact, and other significant events in the church. The annual meeting is also a time when the church membership elects or ratifies new council members.

Typically, the church leadership will also make a summarized financial presentation to the membership regarding the church's current financial position, recent financial performance, and any important trends. This provides a great opportunity for the members to hear about new visions, understand current needs and identify new partnership opportunities.
