

SPIRITUAL GIFTS

1 Corinthians 12:7-11

WISDOM

Ability to understand a biblical perspective on different situations. Speak into situations to encourage believers to respond as the Bible instructs.

KNOWLEDGE

The gift often shows up in a love to study the Bible and communicate God's word to others. Ability and passion for helping others understand the things they are learning.

FAITH

An over-and-above ability to trust God in impossible situations often encouraging others who are struggling in their faith.

HEALING

The supernatural ability given by the Holy Spirit to restore spiritually, mentally, or physically a person who is sick.

MIRACLES

The supernatural ability by the Holy Spirit to perform extraordinary acts that go beyond human understanding for the purpose of revealing God's power and presence.

PROPHECY

Ability to receive and communicate messages from God. Relaying God's words or God's will to someone.

DISCERNMENT

Ability to understand, judge, or to tell the difference between true and false teaching, and between what is of the Holy Spirit and what is not.

TONGUES

Ability to speak in a special, unknown language that hasn't been learned. This can be a way to talk to God in a unique and personal way.

INTERPRETATION

Communicating what someone else has expressed in tongues.

We've outlined the gifts referenced in 1 Corinthians 12 above. If interested, take time as a family to explore other gifts mentioned throughout the Bible. Romans 12 and Ephesians 4 provide great starting points.
