SOUTH ASIA



Pakistan

The opening of the Foursquare Training Center in Peshawar is a step of faith, with hopes for long-term impact among Afghans and local communities.



South Asian Nation*

A recent survey showed discipleship efforts impacting 25 different UPGs, including Hindu and Buddhist groups.

Sri Lanka

The Foursquare Church has a significant ministry to young adults and emerging leaders, especially among the English-speaking churches in Colombo. Young people are being trained and released in

various ministries, including music, the arts, and marketplace ministry.

NORTH ASIA + SINOPHONE NETWORK



Japan

Japan Foursquare has opened its doors to receive missionary workers from the Pacific District, demonstrating a growing commitment to outreach and missions. This collaboration is strengthening the church's global impact.

South Korea

The number of women ministers increased by 8%, reflecting our shared value of empowered leadership.

Taiwan

Taiwan saw a 100% increase in youth engagement through targeted discipleship and camps.

Hong Kong

Decision for Christ numbers increased in Hong Kong by 45 new believers.

Sinophone Network

The newly established network in Seoul, South Korea, is encouraging Chinese pastors to plant churches, start couples' Bible studies, and launch campus ministries. The network is growing and making a significant impact.



North Asia Young Adult Praise Camp

Launched in 2023, the camp saw significant growth in 2024, with campers increasing from 85 to 150. Young adults from Japan, South Korea, China and Taiwan experienced spiritual growth and a sense of family.

SOUTHEAST ASIA



Vietnam

A widow pastoring a small community after a natural disaster sought Foursquare covering, and her church was officially recognized.

Myanmar

Despite ongoing civil war, Myanmar's national movement has grown stronger and more unified.

Philippines

Foursquare Philippines, a robust missionary-sending nation, held its first national Missions Conference in 2024, sending workers to several creative access nations.



Thailand


Thailand hosted the region's first youth conference in over a decade, attracting youth and young adults from more than 12 nations to the Beyond Borders event in Bangkok. This marked a significant breakthrough for the region's NextGen initiatives.



Singapore

A new fellowship led by a Korean woman and her family was launched in Singapore, marking the first new church plant in many years. This small but significant church is a sign of health and growth in the national church.

SOUTH PACIFIC



Solomon Islands

In February 2023, a team from Wellington, New Zealand, discovered the need for a church on the Russell Islands. They embarked on a \$12,000 project to build a church in this remote area, where facilities are scarce, including the absence of toilets.

Fiji

Plans are underway to establish a new Bible school, mission training center, and central church in Lautoka, Fiji. The National Hispanic District has generously contributed over \$40,000 to support this initiative.

Indonesia

Hundreds of Bible school graduates from 2024 are actively planting new churches across Indonesia.

This effort has led to numerous miracles, healings, and spiritual breakthroughs in remote towns and villages.

Palau

The President of Palau invited Foursquare to address the high rates of depression and suicide among the youth. This invitation has opened many doors for ministry, with Foursquare receiving a warm welcome and significant support.



SOUTHERN AFRICA



Eswatini

After the death of a Nigerian businessman who started the ministry, his wife is seeking guidance for its future. Regional leaders visited in November to explore new planting opportunities.

Malawi

Pastor Davis, with Water Wells for Africa and Foursquare Mission Press, is reaching the Yao people through government-mandated Bible education in schools, focusing on Machinga and Mangochi.

Namibia

A School of Ministry was launched in late 2023/early 2024, led by Pastor Festus Negumbo and Dr. Delinda Higgins. Despite personal loss, Pastor Festus continues to lead and pursue further education.

Mozambique

Ten new churches were planted in 2024, including one near Beira, the capital of Sofala Province. This marks significant growth for Foursquare Mozambique.

Zambia


A new church was planted in Lusaka, in partnership with Foursquare Burundi, serving the Kirundi-speaking diaspora and led by Pastor Zechariah.

Zimbabwe

Pastor Juliana Muskwe is transforming lives by rescuing, rehabilitating, and discipling women from crisis situations like human trafficking and abuse, raising them into ministry and providing hope and purpose.



WEST AFRICA/ WAMCO



Equatorial Guinea

In November 2023, a new church was launched with a 3-day crusade led by Rev. Sunday Adebisi. The church was further consolidated in 2024, with a major outreach planned for July 2025.



São Tomé and Príncipe

Following a feasibility study in June 2023, a church was planted in February 2024 with the help of a missionary from Angola. The local community eagerly welcomed the new church.

Ghana


Ghana celebrated 50 years of the Foursquare Gospel in 2024, with President Randy Remington as a special guest. The church has been thriving under the leadership of Dr. Francis Sey.

Liberia

Liberia marked 40 years of Foursquare work in 2024, celebrating with new minister ordinations and leadership appointments. Plans are underway for an administrative building and new church planting areas.



FRANCOPHONE WEST + CENTRAL AFRICA



DR Congo

Nine new churches were planted, including one in Kinshasa and five in Kalemie. This growth is strengthening the church's presence and impact across the country.

Cape Verde

Re-opened through a partnership of Cote d'Ivoire, Guinea Bissau, and Nigeria, marking a significant milestone in 2024. This collaboration has revitalized the ministry in Cape Verde, bringing new hope and opportunities for growth.

Equatorial Guinea

Opened through collaboration with FMI and Nigeria, expanding the reach of the ministry. The new church plant has already begun to make a positive impact in the community, with plans for further outreach and development.

Benin Republic

A former sorcerer converted to Christianity, and a 10-year-old child was brought back to life, showcasing the power of faith.

Central African Republic

Thirteen prisoners were baptized, and numerous healing testimonies were shared, contributing to community and national growth.

Niger

In Niger, Pastor Sarah and a volunteer team lead a growing kids' outreach, providing food, stories, and activities twice a week for 120 children.



EAST AFRICA



Burundi

Outreach to the Batwa people led to over 624 conversions, followed by a discipleship program. Additionally, a national ministry for reaching Muslims was established.

Kenya

During the National Convention, 275 people gave their lives to Jesus through evangelism efforts. The country also saw the establishment of seven new churches and two new meeting points in 2024.

South Sudan

FMI Emmissary Aaron Thompson trained Foursquare leaders and partnered with Bishop Charles to open an orphanage for children affected by war and conflict. This strengthened the local ministry and inspired new works.

Burundi

The School of Mission, running for three years, graduated 86 students in 2024, covering various theological topics. The country also held its first-ever youth camp with 250 participants.


Kenya

The youth ministry held a national conference, training young people on various issues and leadership skills. For the first time, a young leader spoke at the National Convention.

Uganda

A revival among the youth led to a one-week camp attended by 450, where many experienced the Holy Spirit and deliverance from witchcraft. The theme was "OUTPOURING," and God's presence was strongly felt.

EUROPE



Ukraine

Foursquare Ukraine continues to make disciples, plant churches, and serve those affected by Russia's war. Several churches and ministry centers have been established, providing vital support to the community.

Germany

New inroads are being made into the Roma community, with efforts to plant a viable Foursquare movement. This initiative aims to bring the Gospel to one of the most marginalized groups in the region.


Ukraine

A new vehicle was purchased for an orphanage, thanks to generous donations from churches. The funds also provided winter coats and boots for about 40 orphaned and abandoned children, ensuring their well-being during the harsh winter months.

Earthquake-relief efforts in Antakya (ancient Antioch) resulted in a standing-room-only Easter service.

Caucasian Nation

A female pastor who was not allowed to use the title "pastor" was formally recognized within Foursquare and joyfully accepted the title.

France

A young Iranian man, fleeing religious persecution, found a Foursquare church via Google, surrendered to Christ, and was baptized.

AMERICAS



Caribbean

Plans for church planting in Trinidad were established, and a worker moved to St. Lucia to begin efforts in 2025. These initiatives are expanding the church's reach in the Caribbean.

Discipleship Leadership Training (DLT)

The frequency of DLT events increased throughout 2024, with the largest training event held in Medellin, Colombia. Paul Otremba led several training sessions in Colombia, Ecuador, Uruguay, and Brazil, spreading the culture of discipleship.



Ecuador

Ecuador's National Church, along with Paul Otremba, trained and mobilized emerging leaders. These efforts are nurturing future church leaders and strengthening the church's foundation.

Jamaica

Jamaica experienced a fresh move for evangelism, reviving struggling churches.

North Africa

CENTRAL AMERICA



El Salvador

The Semillero Ministerial program graduated its first class, leading to the revival of a church that had been closed for two years.

Honduras

Planted five new churches and 15 new missionary fields in 2024, with plans to expand further.

Nicaragua

Under the leadership of Luis Solis, Nicaragua experienced significant growth in 2024. The church has seen remarkable progress despite facing government pressure.

Mexico

An event for leaders under 40 in Mexico equipped, connected, and encouraged 90 attendees.

This initiative focused on developing the next generation of church leaders.

Panama

The first international youth summit in Panama brought together over 600 people from 17 nations. This event marked a significant milestone for youth ministry in the region.
