





Rearview Mirror Hanger

Scripture tells us that parents/caregivers are to talk with their children about faith as they sit, travel the road, lie down, and get up (Deut. 6). **PLUS** recent research shows that discussing faith in the home is one of **THE** most effective ways to nurture lasting faith in children. Faith conversations, which this resource will spark, not only strengthen relationships within the family but also create opportunities for caregivers to share their faith with the next generation.



How To Connect With Families

We're excited to share a resource designed to help families in your ministry strengthen faith conversations at home. It's intended to spark meaningful discussions during everyday moments, whether that's in the car, at the table, or wherever your families connect.

We know resources are valuable, but more isn't always better. What matters most is engaging families in a meaningful way. Some groups host a "cut-out party" so families can create their own hanger together, while others let families decorate their hanger before taking it home. How To Prep The Resource

Things to gather:

- Cardstock
- Scissors
- Large hole punch or equivalent
- A printed copy of the family guide for each participant

How To:

- Print the rearview mirror hangers on the cardstock
- Cut around the border of each hanger
- Punch a large hole in the top (or cut it out)
- Make a slit at the top of the large hole so the hanger fits onto the rearview mirror

WHY?

Scripture calls parents and caregivers to talk about their faith in everyday life: at home, on the road, in the morning and at night (Deut. 6). Research confirms that faith conversations at home are one of the most effective ways to nurture lasting faith in children. This resource helps spark those conversations, strengthening family bonds and passing faith to the next generation.

HOW?

Simply hang up or carry the hanger that is included, and start asking the questions that are listed!

At first, these discussions may feel scripted or structured, but as they become part of your routine, your child(ren) will begin to lead the way with questions and open sharing.

WHEN?

Consider the time you spend in the vehicle each day. During daily commutes, use the 3 prompts to spark conversations with your family. Make it a fun and regular part of your routine.
