

## A Brief Statement of Discovery

Does it exist? This is the fundamental question that establishes the reality of all of human experience. The question is not object, force or relationship specific. It...is anything that can possibly exist.

All of human understanding is contained within human experience. We are collectively convinced that we can model the universe with a complete, accurate and unchanging system. If we have the correct model we do not expect to have to make excuses for observed exceptions. We collectively assume that the universe is ruled with exception less laws of fundamental unchanging truth. This, in fact, is not supported by human experience.
