- ☐ The student's NCAA ID, high school graduation year, permanent address and phone number should be included with the aforementioned documentation.
- ☐ A signed [Federal Buckley Amendment Release Form](#) is required for the NCAA to discuss the student's EID request with anyone other than the student. A parent/legal guardian who would like to discuss a student's EID request with the NCAA must be listed on the Federal Buckley Amendment Release Form.
