Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and income ■ account balances and payment history ■ credit history and credit score
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. Introduction

Welcome to Funding University. This Privacy Statement describes how Funding University collects, receives and shares information about you from our website and any off-line communications we may have with you, e.g. emails, telephone calls, and personal communication, located at <http://Funding-University.com>. This Privacy Policy, together with our Terms of Use govern your use of our website and our collection and use of your information.

What Information Does Funding University Collect From Visitors and Borrowers?

Funding University collects the following information from students and visitors to our website:

- information you provide on our website such as contact information, school affiliation or feedback; and

We may use cookies and similar technologies such as web beacons to support the functionality of our customer portal, monitor traffic patterns and collect information about your previous visits to our website.

How Does Funding University Use Information Collected From Visitors to This Website?
