**About this example**

The repayment examples assume that you remain in school for up to 4 years and have a 6 month grace period before beginning repayment for a total of 51 months of in-school partial payments. It is based on the **highest starting rate currently charged** and associated fees. Repayment will last 10 years starting once the initial principal payment is made.

### Fixed Interest Rate

### Eligibility Criteria

#### Borrower

- Must be the age of majority in your home state or older at the time you apply.
- Must be US Citizen or Permanent Resident with a valid I-551 card.
- State residency restrictions may apply.
- Borrower is subject to credit approval and debt to income requirements. Additional documentation may be required.

#### Cosigners

- Cosigners are not available for this loan.

### Bankruptcy Limitations

- If you file for bankruptcy, you may still be required to pay back this loan.
