



Congregation COVID Policy Update September 7, 2021

During the pandemic, our goal has always been to care for the health, safety, and well-being of our staff, our congregation, and our community. It is prudent for us to continue to protect our most vulnerable, especially our children and youth while they await access to vaccines. **When Oakland County has a “high” or “substantial” transmission rate, as it does now, we require that everyone over the age of 2 wear a face mask in public areas of the building, including worship spaces.** Masks should cover the nose and mouth. Masks may be removed when eating or drinking and in small group gatherings, although you are always welcome to wear one.
