

Exodus 3:16

Go and assemble the **elders** of Israel and say to them: The Lord, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, has appeared to me and said: I have paid close attention to you and to what has been done to you in Egypt. As the Apostles established leadership in the newly planted churches, they naturally took this OT pattern of Elders and made it the NT practice!

Acts 14:23

And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, with prayer and fasting they committed them to the Lord in whom they had believed.

The NT uses three different words to refer to elders

Acts 20: 17


Now from Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called the **elders** of the church to come to him.

Acts 20:28

Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you **overseers**, to **care for** the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood.

The prescription Peter offers for a healthy church:

In a healthy church, the elders will shepherd and the flock will submit, all in a spirit of mutual humility.

So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed...

For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God...

So Lexhort (urge, beg) the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed...

 - The **WHAT?** of the task:

1 Peter 5:2

... **shepherd** the flock of God that is among you, **exercising oversight**,

1 Timothy 5:17

Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in preaching and teaching.

To FEED the flock

To LEAD the flock

The elders will shepherd by **LEADING** the flock

1 Timothy 3:4-5

He must **manage** his own family well and see that his children obey him with proper respect. 5(If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?)

1 Timothy 5:17

Let the elders who rule...

The elders will shepherd by **FEEDING** the flock

1 Timothy 5:17 The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching.

1 Timothy 3:2 Now the overseer must be . . . able to teach.

The elders will shepherd by **FEEDING** the flock

<u>Titus 1:9</u> He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and <u>refute those who oppose it.</u>

A vital part of this responsibility to **FEED** the flock is to guard the flock from error!

Acts 20:29-31a

I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be alert ...

- 1. This task of elders is **URGENT!**
- 2. This task of the elders is **CLEAR!**
 - The WHAT? of the task . . . shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight,
 - Elders are to RULE/LEAD and TEACH/FEED (guard) the flock!

The **HOW?** of the task of shepherding

1 Peter 5:2

shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you;

Elders need to shepherd with a willing heart!

The **HOW?** of the task of shepherding

1 Peter 5:2 not for shameful gain, but eagerly;

Elders need to shepherd with an eager heart!

"God's shepherds should have an attitude of self sacrificial zeal - not merely a willingness to serve but an authentic enthusiasm that springs from the heart. This principle flies in the face of the excessive professionalism common in the ministry today. Degrees, resumes, popularity, and references don't qualify a person for ministry. Rather, an eagerness to serve - occasionally at great personal cost - is a vital ingredient found in a well-rounded Shepherd and well grounded ministry."

But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, 27 and whoever would be first among you must be your slave.

- Very worthwhile!







1 Peter 5:5a

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another,

What is humility is NOT!

Humility is <u>not</u> self deprecation – in which a person gets down on himself or herself and says,"I am a loser! I can't do this!I am just a humble nobody!"



What is humility?

2 Corinthians 3:5

Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God.

So humility is being aware of our own insufficiency while trusting in Christ's all-sufficiency!

The elders are to shepherd and the flock is to submit . . . "all in a spirit of mutual humility."

1 Peter 5:5

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

Have you ever received the gift of grace he offers to you in Jesus Christ?



Romans 6:23

The wages of sin is death, but **the gift** of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.



And who among your network of relationships needs to hear this good news about Jesus Christ?

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
