





John 8:31-38

We are facing a crisis of truth!






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Theologians have a word to describe the knowability of the Bible – **perspicuity.**

This word is used to describe the fact that the Bible can be clearly understood.





"The doctrine of the clarity of Scripture is not a wild assertion that the meaning of every verse in the Bible will be patently obvious to everyone. Rather, the perspicuity of Scripture upholds the notion that ordinary people using ordinary means can accurately understand enough of what must be known, believed, and observed for them to be faithful Christians." (Kevin DeYoung)
