Lemon-Raspberry Cake

Prep Time: 10 min

Start to Finish: 1hr 50min.

15 Servings

Cake

1 package lemon cake mix with pudding in the mix

1 1/4 cups water

1/3 cup vegetable oil

3 eggs

6 tablespoons raspberry preserves

Lemon Buttercream Frosting

1 1/4 cups butter or margarine, softened

2 teaspoons grated lemon peel

3 tablespoons lemon juice

3 cups powdered sugar

Garnish

Fresh raspberries, if desired



1. Heat oven to 350 F. Grease bottoms and sides of 3 9 inch round pans with shortening or cooking spray; lightly flour. Make cake mix as directed on package, using water, oil, and eggs. Pour into pans.
2. Bake 18-20 min. or until toothpick inserted comes out clean. Cool 10 min.; remove from pans to wire rack. Cool about an hour.
3. In med bowl, beat butter, lemon peel and lemon juice with electric mixer on med speed 30 seconds. Gradually beat in powdered sugar. Beat 2-3 min longer or until light and fluffy.
4. On serving plate, place 1 cake layer, rounded side down. Spread 3 tablespoons jam, continue next cake layers. On third layer, rounded side up. Frost side and top of cake with frosting. Store covered in re-

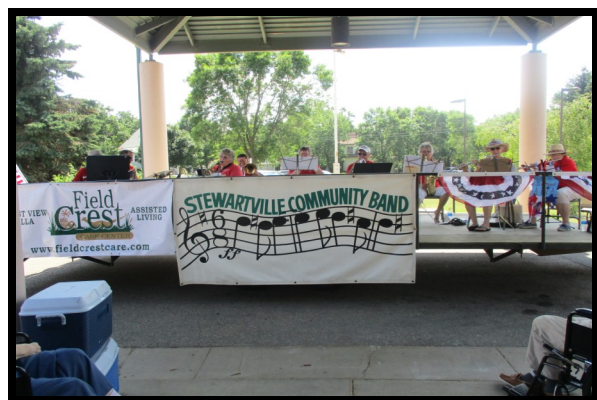
