As residents of our community for over 30 years, we (Jim Adam & Ron Schreiber) have helped champion what is now the Northwest Open Space. When the City's request for new proposals came about, we have formally decided to come forth as the Community Bid to uphold the long-standing traditions and historical character of San Juan Capistrano. We have spoken with dozens of community members and have formulated our low-impact plan which we believe will maintain and further enhance the Northwest Open Space. We have assembled a team of qualified real estate, construction and operational experts to help aid us in our vision.

The vision of this project is to create a space that our family, your family and the entire community will enjoy for generations to come. In order for this to happen, we strongly believe that this unique space needs to be preserved and further enhanced into an amenity rich property for everyone in the community to enjoy, while keeping the open space open. This includes carrying the existing theme of Putudiem Village through much of the property, adding walking & horse trails, stables, a riding coral, horseshoe courts, community gardens, lawn bowling, and other low-impact outdoor activities that allow people to safely gather and enjoy nature.
