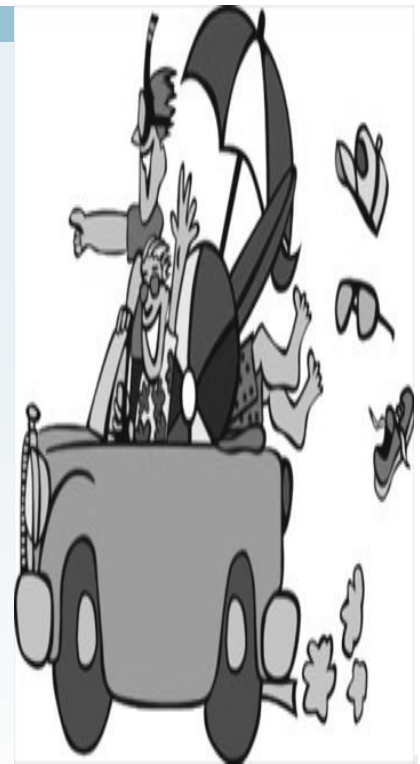
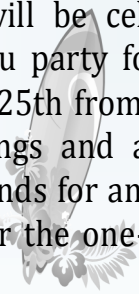


Family Luau Party
