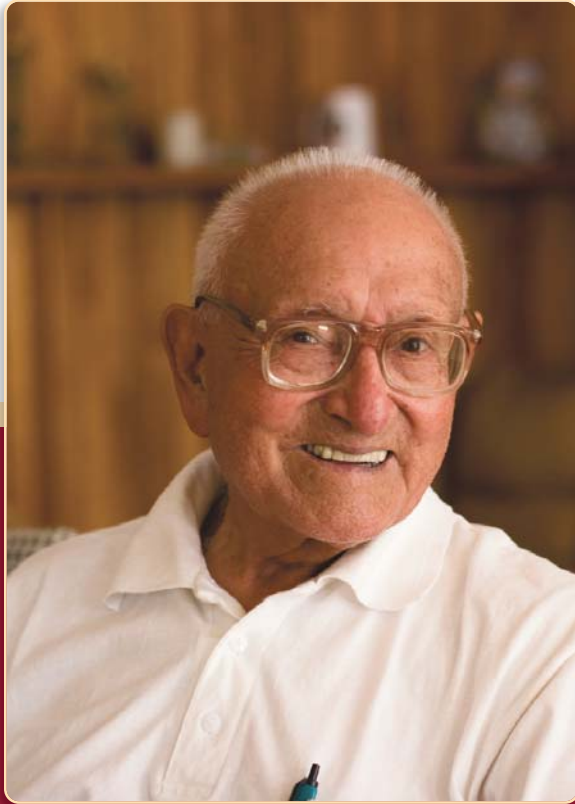

Lutheran Home of Southbury is located off I-84 at 990 Main Street North in Southbury, CT:

- Take I-84 to Exit 15.
- Proceed north on Main Street North (Route 6) for approximately 1.5 miles.
- You will see an oval sign for Lutheran Home of Southbury on the right-hand corner of Main Street North and Dublin Hill Road.
- Turn right onto Dublin Hill Road.
- The Center's parking entrance will be on your left.
