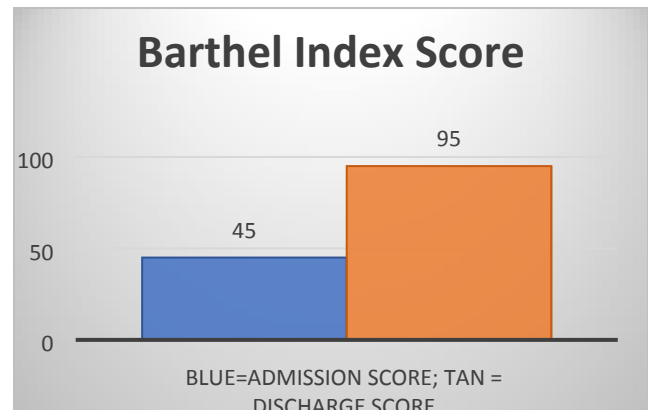

He received Physical, Speech, and Occupational Therapy in preparation to return home. His Activities of Daily Living Outcomes are:



This assessment indicates that he improved from completing activities of daily living with 45% independence improving to 95% independent at discharge (a 50% increase over the course of a month). Although his orders were to remain toe-touch weightbearing on his right knee, he did improve to return home with home health support, a front wheeled walker, and knee brace that allowed him to flex the right knee up to 30 degrees.

With speech therapy he improved cognition, safety awareness, recall and comprehension. We are proud to see Patrick return home safely with home health services to follow him!
