Henry Cisneros, Executive Chairman of City View and former Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and other state and local officials helped break ground on Darson Marie Terrace, San Antonio's newest affordable senior apartment community, at a groundbreaking ceremony on Wednesday, August 19th. Darson Marie Terrace will be a HUD 202 and Tax Credit community for older adults with 56 one-bedroom units and a two-bedroom manager's unit. All units will feature a full kitchen and living room and a bathroom with built-in safety features. The shared areas of this community will include a lobby with a comfortable seating area, a community room with a kitchen, an exercise room, a computer room, a library, an arts and crafts room, and a central laundry room. Darson Marie Terrace will be RHF's 14th community in Texas and its third in San Antonio. This community has been financed through a partnership with Wells Fargo Bank, The Department of Housing and Urban Development, Bexar County, RHF Foundation, Inc. and Angelus Trust.
