Again, we welcome you and hope you enjoy your new home.

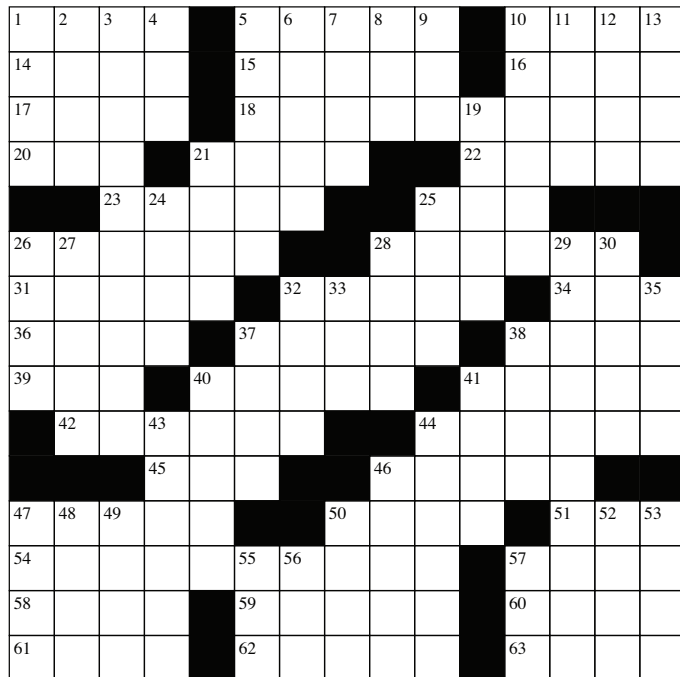
