- * Carotid artery ultrasound

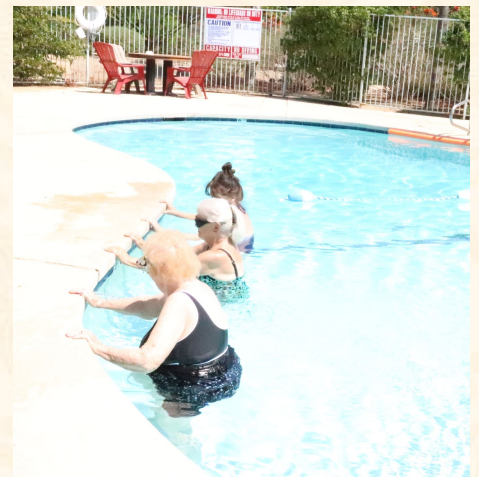
- * Abdominal aortic ultrasound

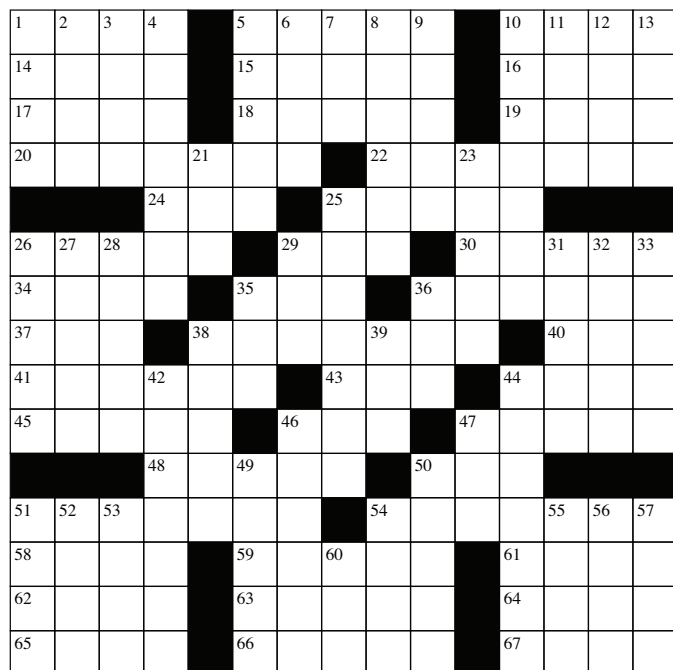
