#### Geography 101: Tristan da Cunha

The world's most remote inhabited island lies halfway between South America and Africa in the South Atlantic Ocean, and the closest community is 1,500 miles away. Named after the explorer who discovered it in 1506, Tristan da Cunha is a British overseas territory with about 250 residents. The island is accessible only by ship, and those who wish to visit must get prior approval, then depart from Cape Town, South Africa, for a weeklong journey on the sea. The ships, which arrive a few times a year, also transport supplies and mail to the residents.
