Message Text: Romans 14:12

Introduction:

In our sin cursed humanity rebel against accountability especially toward God. For the person who is not living according to God's revealed truth, the message of revealed accountability can cause great anger. Think about king Jehoiakim and how he responded to hearing the Word of God from Jeremiah in Jeremiah 36. He took the scroll, cut it up and threw it in the fire burning in the hearth. From the earliest pages in Scripture until the last chapter, our accountability to our God is emphasized and we do well to live daily with it in mind.
