# 3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Repopulation (3-36)

### A. In the City of \_\_\_\_\_ (3-24)

Nehemiah 11:3 Now these are the chief of the province that dwelt in Jerusalem: but in the cities of Judah dwelt every one in his possession in their cities, to wit, Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants.

NOTE —The men who moved to Jerusalem were described as valiant men, men of valour and great men (11:6,14).

THE TRIBE OF JUDAH — 468 (4-6)

THE TRIBE OF BENJAMIN — 928 (7-9)

THE PRIESTS — 1,192 (10-14): A sub-section of the tribe of Levi and descendants of Aaron.

Ezekiel 44:23 And they [Priests] shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

THE TRIBE OF LEVI — 456 (15-19): oversight of the outward business of the House of God. They provided support to the priests.

Nehemiah 11:16 And Shabbethai and Jozabad, of the chief of the Levites, had the oversight of the outward business of the house of God.

TEMPLE SAFETY — the porters, gatekeepers

Nehemiah 11:19 Moreover the porters, Akkub, Talmon, and their brethren that kept the gates, were an hundred seventy and two.

TEMPLE SERVANTS — the Nethinims, served along side of the Levites

Nehemiah 11:21 But the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel: and Ziha and Gispa were over the Nethinims.

TEMPLE SINGERS — overseeing prayer, thanksgiving and singing

Nehemiah 11:17 And Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, was the principal to begin the thanksgiving in prayer: and Bakbukiah the second among his brethren, and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.

Nehemiah 11:22–23 The overseer also of the Levites at Jerusalem was Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha. Of the

sons of Asaph, the singers were over the business of the house of God. 23 For it was the king's commandment concerning them, that a certain portion should be for the singers, due for every day.

NOTE — The number of people in Jerusalem would be 3,044 out of 30,447 (7:6-71).

QUOTE: [The tribes of Judah and Benjamin] 'had stayed with David's heirs, to form the kingdom of Judah when the rest had broken away; now the future of Israel lay with them and with those who had rallied to them from the other tribes'.—Kidner

NOTE — The Levites dwelt among the tribes of Judah and Benjamin enabling them to see to the spiritual wellbeing of the people.

Nehemiah 11:36 And of the Levites were divisions in Judah, and in Benjamin.
