It has been decided to postpone the opening of the term from Wednesday, September 20, to *Tuesday*, October 3. This action, similar to that taken by some other colleges, is in order to minimize as far as possible any danger there may be of infection from students coming from localities that have been visited by infantile paralysis. The decision should be regarded as a measure of added precaution rather than as a result of any known necessity.

Any student who has during the vacation been in a house, or in the immediate neighborhood, where a case of infantile paralysis has occurred, or who has in any other way knowingly been exposed to the possibility of contagion, should communicate the circumstances to the President and not come to the College before receiving permission.

The way in which the time thus lost is to be made up will be determined at a later date.

The Entrance Examinations scheduled for September 19-21 will be held at the College October 3-5.
