

# The Great Give® 2019 Prizes\*

**\$216,000+ in matching funds and prizes**

## **MATCHING GIFT INCENTIVES** - Matching gifts are a powerful tool!

**The Community Foundation for Greater New Haven** is providing a matching pool of \$50,000, to which Alexion Pharmaceuticals Inc. is adding a matching pool of \$5,000. All donations made during the 36-hour period of The Great Give® 2019 to participating nonprofits will receive a prorated portion of a \$55,000 match pool. (As an example, if the match pool is \$55,000 and the total amount raised that day is \$500,000, then a \$1 donation would become \$1.11.)

**The Valley Community Foundation** has set aside a matching pool of \$20,000. All donations made during the 36-hour period of The Great Give® 2019 by Valley donors<sup>a</sup> to participating nonprofits will receive a prorated portion of the match pool. (As an example, if the match pool is \$20,000 and the total amount raised from Valley donors<sup>a</sup> that day is \$60,000, then a \$1 donation would become \$1.33.)

**The Konopacke Match** – The Konopacke Fund of The Community Foundation for Greater New Haven is providing a matching pool of up to \$10,000 to inspire giving to independent, nonprofit animal shelters. Eligible organizations will receive a prorated match for all gifts received during the 36-hour period of The Great Give® 2019 in addition to the prorated share of the Foundations' matching pools.

**Bank of America Performing Arts Challenge** – The Bank of America Charitable Foundation is providing a matching pool of \$5,000 for all donations by donors to participating performing arts organizations. All qualifying donations made during The Great Give® 2019 will receive a prorated portion of the match pool determined by the number of donors in addition to the prorated share of the Foundations' matching pools.

**KeyBank** is providing \$5,000 in matching funds for a select group of nonprofits focused on empowering women and children. All qualifying donations made during The Great Give® 2019 will receive a prorated portion of the match pool determined by the number of donors in addition to the prorated share of the Foundations' matching pools.

### **Most Money Raised**



By an organization with no paid staff - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$3,000 – Sponsored by an anonymous donor



By an organization with only part-time staff - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$3,000 – Sponsored by an anonymous donor



By an organization with fewer than 1-6 FTE staff members - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$3,000




By an organization with 7-29 FTE staff members - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$3,000



By an organization with more than 30 staff members - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$3,000

**You've Got Friends** – to the organization with the highest number of Peer-to-Peer fundraisers who each raise \$250 or more

**COMPETITIVE HOURLY PRIZES** - The following Competitive Hourly Prizes are being provided by The Community Foundation for Greater New Haven, unless otherwise noted. (*Competitive Hourly Prize recipients are additionally eligible for all Grand prizes and match; Competitive Hourly Prize recipients can only receive one competitive hourly prize; the higher prize amount prevails.*):

 **Happy Hour Prize** - \$1,000 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on May 1


 **Night Owl Prize** - \$500 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 1:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. on May 2


 **Insomnia Prize** - \$500 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 2:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m. on May 2


 **Sunrise Prize** - \$500 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 5:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on May 2

 **Seize the Day Prize** - \$1,000 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on May 2


 **Valley Lucky Draw Prize** - \$250 to a Valley organization<sup>b</sup> randomly drawn from all Valley organizations with at least 25 gifts secured between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on May 2; awarded by The Valley Community Foundation


 **Extended Lunch Hour Prize** - \$1,000 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. on May 2


 **Valley Lucky Draw Prize** - \$250 to a Valley organization<sup>b</sup> randomly drawn from all Valley organizations with at least 25 gifts secured between 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on May 2; awarded by The Valley Community Foundation


 **Last Call Happy Hour Prize** - \$1,000 awarded to the organization with the greatest number of gifts from unique donors between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on May 2


**GOLDEN TICKETS AND RANDOM DRAWINGS** - Grant prizes awarded under this category are designed to keep momentum going throughout The Great Give® 2019.


 **Donor Choice Prize** – One donor who gives between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on May 1 will be randomly chosen to designate a prize of \$250 to the organization of his/her choice

 **The Daily Double Prize** – \$250 added to a gift of \$250 or more made between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on May 1; gift chosen at random

 **Midnight Snack Prize** - \$500 added to the gift made closest to 12:00 a.m. on May 2


 **Donor Choice Prize** – One donor who gives between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on May 2 will be randomly chosen to designate a prize of \$250 to the organization of his/her choice

 **The Daily Double Prize** – \$250 added to a gift of \$250 (or more) made between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on May 2; gift chosen at random

#### **BAD SONS Charity Tap Happy Hour Prizes**

The Taproom at BAD SONS Beer Co. (open seven days each week) has a Charity Tap, where part of the proceeds from each sale are pooled for good causes. Between April 1 and May 2 BAD SONS patrons can use their receipt from beer purchased from the Charity Tap to vote for the winner. Patrons can select their favorite charity from all the Valley-based organizations<sup>b</sup> participating in The Great Give. The organization with the most votes at 8:00pm on May 2 will get the Charity Tap Prize Pool (at least \$1,000)! And the fun continues – the organization with the most votes between May 3 and May 31 will get the Charity Tap Pool for May!

 \$500 each to the top two Branford-based organizations with the most Branford-resident unique donors; winner cannot win a grand prize of higher value

#### **The Guilford Foundation Prizes**

 \$500 each to the top two Guilford-based organizations with the most Guilford-resident unique donors; winner cannot win a grand prize of higher value
