WHY HOPE 4 YOUTH?

- For every essential item you donate, you will provide critical support to youth experiencing homelessness.
- In 2024, youth made over 3,471 visits to our Pantry.
- In 2024, we supported a record number of 5,158 youth visits to our HOPE 4 Youth Center in Anoka.
- 30% of youth visiting our H4Y Center are parenting their own children. Your donations support individual youth and families.

HOW DO YOU MAKE AN IMPACT?

- Every youth that uses our pantry for essential items is able to personally choose their items to fill three bags of support. These items include food, hygiene, diapers, water, and paper products like toilet paper and kleenex.
- So far in 2025, from January-June, we have had 2,910 visits to our Center. This is already an increase of 58% for this time this year compared to 2024.

HOW TO HOST A DONATION DRIVE?

You can host a donation drive by yourself or as a group! Your work, school, friends, family, and community are perfect supporters to help you reach your goal.

EXAMPLES OF DONATION DRIVES:

TIMED COLLECTION

A donation drive with a specific time period you will be collecting items.

DROP & COLLECT

Provide grocery bags to your local group or community, set a designated amount of time they can collect items, and then gather the bags once filled with items.

DONATION DRIVE DAY/EVENT

Plan a specific date and time to host a donation drive.

VIRTUAL DONATION DRIVE

Use our H4Y virtual wish lists at Target, Walmart, and Amazon to share our top needs OR create your own list of items you would like to collect.

HOW TO HOST A DONATION DRIVE?

STEP 1: BRAINSTORM

Think about what kind of drive you want to host. In person or virtual? Will you collect donations yourself or ask people to bring them to a location? How will you share about your drive?

STEP 2: TIMELINE

Determine the length of your drive Do you want it to be a one day event or over a period of time?

STEP 3: WHAT TO COLLECT

Choose which item(s) you will be collecting to support H4Y. Food? Hygiene? Clothing?

STEP 4: GET CREATIVE

Create posters, social media posts, and other ways to build excitement.

STEP 5: GET READY, GET SET, GO!

Your drive is now ready! It's time to start!

STEP 5: THAT'S A WRAP




















HOPE YOUTH HOPE 4 YOUTH

OUR MISSION: To provide pathways to end youth homelessness

All youth will feel safe, valued, and supported while reaching their full potential. This begins with meeting their basic needs and leads to giving them the tools to thrive.

OUR PROGRAMS

HOPF 4 Youth Center



The HOPE 4 Youth Center in Anoka is a safe, non-judgmental place for all youth who are in need. Youth can visit for a hot meal, clothing, hygiene, food items, shower, laundry facilities, etc. Our Youth Coordinators connect youth to stable housing, health and wellness programs, education and employment opportunities, and more. In addition, we offer on-site professional services through community partners.

Outreach & Prevention



Our HOPE 4 Youth Outreach and Prevention Programming connects youth to resources and support to assist in preventing homelessness. We do this through engagement with local high schools and community outreach to connect youth with age-appropriate resources such as Host Homes. Family Crisis Management, and Housing Support.

HOPF Place



HOPE Place is our 12-unit transitional housing facility in Coon Rapids that offers supportive services to 18 to 24 year olds who are experiencing homelessness. HOPE Place staff and community partners provide on-site case management. including education and employment guidance, aimed at promoting self-sufficiency and long-term success.

In 2024, we served 650 youth; a 32% increase over last year. We provided services for 5,158 visits.

OUR APPROACH

Partner in Prevention

HOPE 4 Youth supports prevention through strong partnerships and youth alliances.

We work with local school districts, Early Childhood Family Education, Anoka County, Streetworks, Family Homeless Prevention and Assistance Program, Homework Starts with Home, YMCA, and more.

Meeting Basic Needs

HOPE 4 Youth meets youth where they are using a four-fold approach: trauma-informed care, strength-based, client-centered, and harm reduction.

We do this through our HOPE 4 Youth Center by providing a safe place to rest, warm meals, grab and go food, hygiene products, a shower, laundry facilities, and more.

Empowered to Launch

HOPE 4 Youth provides youth resources, connections, training, employment readiness, and educational advancement.

We meet youth where they are by providing support and resources to launch them forward with the goal of leading them to be self-sufficient and experience long-term success.
