The High School Placement Test (HSPT) is a standardized test administered to eighth-grade students to determine acceptance or placement in the ninth-grade classes of parochial schools. The test was formulated by the Scholastic Testing Service (STS) and is sometimes referred to by that name, or by the term “STS- HSPT.”

Since the HSPT is used for admission by a great many Catholic schools, the test is offered in customized form to those schools desiring additional admission criteria, such as mechanical aptitudes, scientific knowledge, or religious knowledge. The conventional test is consistent with state-mandated testing in the areas of language skill, vocabulary, and reading. In the mathematics sections, the test content is also consistent with state requirements in arithmetic, basic geometry and algebra.
