This is in response to your request for affirmation of your organization's exempt status.

Our records indicate that your organization is included in a group ruling issued to Protestant Episcopal Church In The United States Of America, which is located in New York, York.


Protestant Episcopal Church In The United States Of America, is exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is classified as a public charity, and not a private foundation, because it is described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i) of the Code as a church.

As your organization is included in a group ruling, it does not have an individual exemption letter. The group exemption letter applies to all of the subordinate organizations on whose behalf the Protestant Episcopal Church In The United States Of America, has applied for recognition of exemption. This means your organization is also exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

Donors may deduct contributions to your organization as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to your organization or for its use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.
