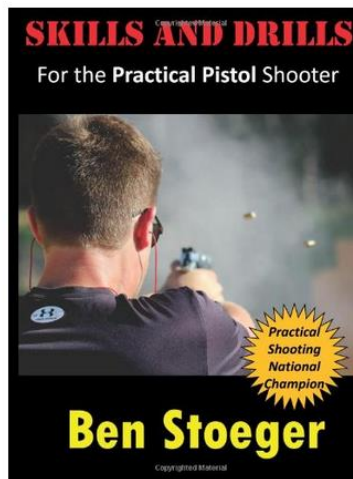
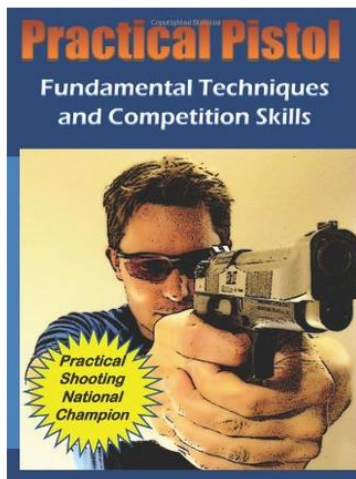

## Class #1: Practical Shooting: Fundamentals

- **Days:** Sat Nov 3 - Sun Nov 4, 2018
- **Cost:** \$385
- **Class Hours:** 9AM - 5PM
- **# Students:** 12
- **Expected Round Count:** 1500 for 2 days

### Class Description (from Ben's web site):

*This is the flagship class. We work on fundamental USPSA skills and apply them in a stage environment. We shoot a mix of drills and stages.*

*We also work on hitting small targets, moving around through stages, and breaking down stages. Don't let the "Fundamentals" in the title for this class mislead you. This isn't a class for new shooters. This is geared towards people that already shoot USPSA, understand scoring and safety rules, and want to improve.*

*Students should leave class with an idea about how to dry practice more efficiently and how to improve the foundation skills for USPSA.*

If you are not currently shooting USPSA but are an action pistol competitor (e.g. IDPA, 3-Gun, Outlaw, etc.) then this class will definitely benefit you. If you have questions as to whether this class would be right for you, please contact the class host (Chris Magyar).

## Class #2: Practical Shooting: Skills & Drills

- **Days:** Mon Nov 5 - Tue Nov 6, 2018
- **Cost:** \$550
- **Class Hours:** 9AM - 5PM
- **# Students:** 6-8
- **Expected Round Count:** 1500+ for 2 days

### Class Description (from Ben's web site):

*This is a "how to train" class. Whatever level you are at, at the end of the class you should have a good idea of how to get to the next level. We work through a variety of drills from "Skills and Drills" and shoot stages.*

*This class features difficult scenario style drills and very little fundamental practice. The emphasis in this class is on learning how to do live fire practice sessions.*

*This is a class that is best done with a smaller group. I also strongly recommend that you have done a Fundamentals class before moving on to this one.*

## Expectations

- Show up at the range 30-60 minutes early; we plan to start at 9AM sharp
- Bring lunch 30m (if possible) avoid going off-range for lunch
- Bring plenty of hydration and snacks
- Bring appropriate attire: hat, sun screen, bug spray, rain gear, etc.
- Bring your competition gear: A working, cleaned/lubed, sighted-in handgun & working ammo. A backup plan is advisable (backup gun, tools, spare parts, fiber, etc.)
- **Everyone** must sign the BGTC Liability waiver before participating
- Follow BGTC range, safe gun handling and class rules
- Unsafe gun-handling practices will not be tolerated
