I give to daughter Hesse Prothro one Negro Girl named Lyda. I give to my son Eli Hickson one negro boy named Daniel. I give to my son Levi Hickson one negro boy named Amos. I give to my son John Hickson one negro boy named Demsey. I give to my son James Hickson one negro Girl named Milley. I give to my Daughter Salley Hickson one negro Girl name Rose

Lastly I do Constitute and Appoint my Well Beloved wife Salley Hickson, William Prothro, Jacob Morriss, Snr, Executors to See This my last will and testament Performed
